

DELIVERY MODEL

This is a self directed qualification with learning expected to take part in your own time using the resources and materials provided to you by Think Tank Academy.

A Think Tank professional will support you to choose the correct pathway and learning for you. We will then provide guidance around how to use it's systems to ensure an effective and meaningful learning experience.

You will gain access to Think Tank's LMS system where you will be able to access and complete any necessary written assessment, as well as upload it for an assessor to mark and provide feedback.

Think Tank's LMS system will provide you with a digital Apprenti-Kit which will provide workbooks and textbooks to support written submission.

Think Tank Academy expect learners to plan and prioritise their learning based on their own commitments. Your assigned assessor can support with this planning whilst onboarding onto the qualification and Think Tank's systems.

A Think Tank Academy Professional will invite you to a monthly support session where they can provide assignment support, feedback and inform the planning of observations and gathering of work place evidence.

ASSESSMENT

The units within this qualification require written based assignments to be submitted at regular intervals through Think Tank's digital platform. Written assessment will be marked by an education professional who has experience of your sector. They will then provide feedback to you via your preferred communication method.

This qualification requires an observation of your work based practice and the sharing of work based evidence - your manager will need to be informed of your learning and assist with this. It may also be necessary to complete professional discussions with an assessor to ensure all learning criteria are comprehensively met.

TIMESCALES

It is expected that learners take ownership of their learning and have the overall control of their completion date and rate of submission.

Learners will be entitled to a maximum of 12 months support from Think Tank Academy, with the vast majority of learners expected to finish much earlier than this.

There is no minimum completion time and learners are encouraged to plan and contribute to their portfolio at regular intervals. A Think Tank Professional can support with this during onboarding or during a planned monthly support session.

LEARNING MATERIALS

You will be provided with access to Think Tank Academy's Learner Management System where you will access relevant reading and further learning to support your studies.

SUPPORT

You will be assigned an assessor with Think Tank Academy who will be responsible for managing and reviewing your online portfolio throughout your time studying.

You will be invited to a support session each month which is offered to support learners with written submissions to help plan observations and the gathering of any work product evidence.

These workshops are informed by learners current workloads and area of study. There may be other professionals attending a workshop which provides a great opportunity to share practice and peer to peer learning methods.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When Can I Start Studying?

Enrolment onto the various pathways is flexible and determined by a learner themselves.

Are There Entry Requirements?

There are no prior learning requirements needed to access this qualification.

It is expected that you are currently working or soon to be working within a suitable Health and Social Care setting related to your qualification and chosen specialism

When Can I Finish Studying?

A completion date is to be set by the learner and agreed with their assessor. There is no minimum time needed to complete the qualification and timescales are determined by a learners commitment to completion

What Would My Next Steps Be?

This qualification ensures compliance and competence required to work in an Adult Social Care setting and can enable learners to fulfil senior care positions.

Learners who complete this diploma commonly progress onto completing a Level 5 Diploma in Leadership & Management to prepare them for a management role within the sector.
